QUALIFICATIONS TO RECEIVE A FAN

Distribution of fans will begin on June 1st.

REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY

1. Must not have received a fan from us before
(If you have and it is broken, return it and we will replace it.)
2. Must reside in Harrison County
3. Provide identification (Picture ID) and proof of current address;
4. You must have a CURRENT Electric Bill for your residence
5. Proof of income for applicant and other adults in the home and meet minimum income requirements.

OR

There must be some Special Circumstance that would render the fan necessary. This includes special medical problems, elderly, infants in the home, etc.
